The first major UK exhibition of new and critically acclaimed work by Amar Kanwar. The exhibition centres on *The Sovereign Forest* (2012–), an installation of film, books and organic materials, which explores the impact of mining and other commercial activities on the landscape and communities of Odisha, India.

The exhibition debuts a new commission especially for YSP. Sited around the Bothy Garden, *The Listening Benches* are recycled from the timber of a 19th century organ formerly housed in YSP Chapel and are Kanwar's first sculptural objects for the open air.

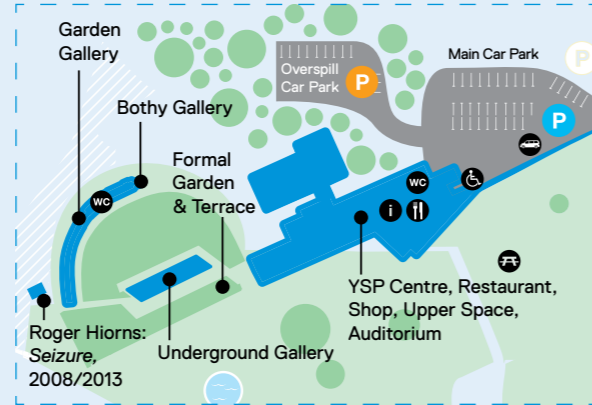

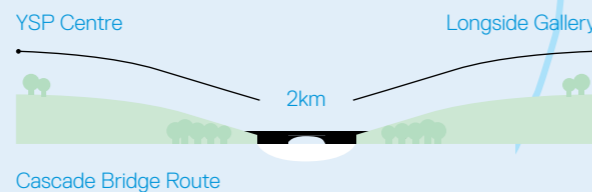

YSP is located in the 500 acre Bretton Estate. On the northern side is the YSP Centre, Underground, Bothy and Garden Galleries and on the southern side you'll find Longside Gallery, a space shared with the Arts Council Collection.
