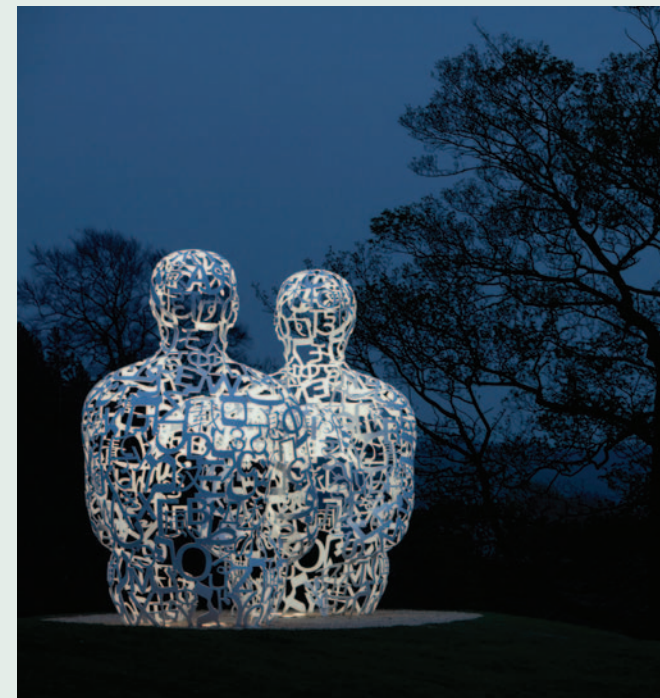

RACHEL GOODYEAR *MODIFICATIONS OF THE HOST*

Rachel Goodyear's compelling cast of characters inhabits a strange and complex world of contradictions, existing somewhere between the macabre and mundane. Exploring themes of fear, desire, vulnerability and isolation, Goodyear invites the viewer into a dark place where human psychologies and animal behaviour collide and merge.

The exhibition features commissioned works alongside recent drawings, including a new series inspired by the physical and imagined landscape at YSP, resulting, for the first time in the artist's career, in small-scale sculpture.

AENEAS WILDER *UNTITLED # 155*

The first major UK installation by Aeneas Wilder, conceived especially for Longside Gallery continues this autumn. Referencing minimalism and autodestructive art, Wilder uses uniform lengths of wood, without any fixing materials, to make freestanding and increasingly complex structures that are awe-inspiring to behold.

As with many of his works, *Untitled # 155* will be completed by a kick down event, a powerful act that brings the structure crashing systematically to the floor. Watch this event online at ysp.co.uk from 3 November.

Between is a new performance exploring the tension between visual spectacle and the hunger for intimacy. One dancer embeds herself within the audience, her arm covered loosely in gold leaf, while another is preoccupied in her private space, absorbed in subtle activity hidden from view.

This stunning work plays with polarised experiences in which attention is both directed and split, exploring the relationships between distance and actual contact, between frenetic and barely visible action, and between roles and identities of spectator and participant.

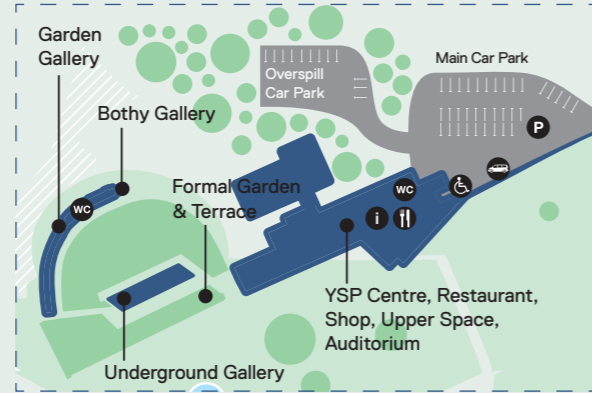

MAP DETAIL

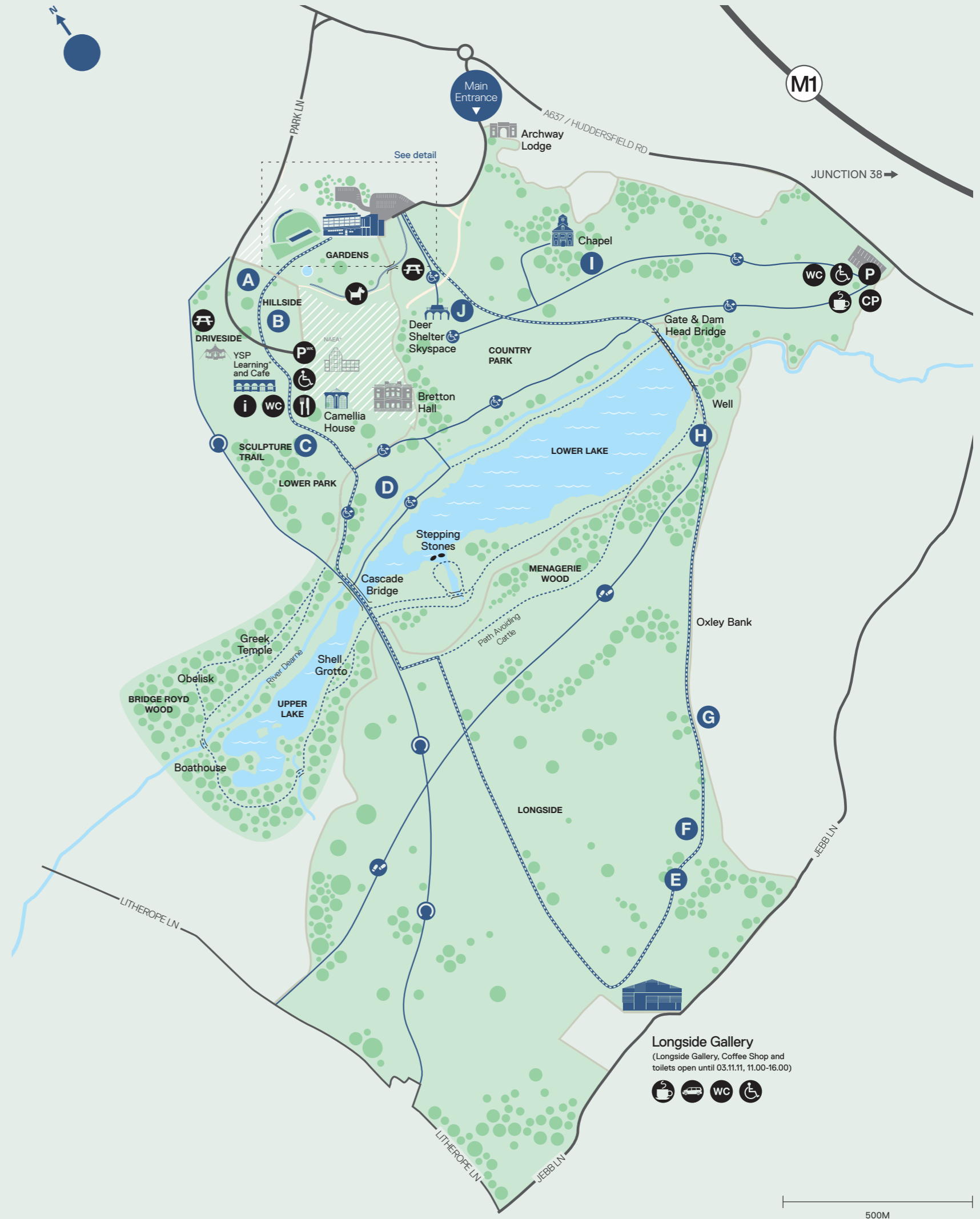
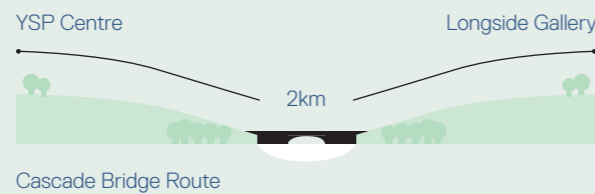

YSP is located in the 500 acre Bretton Estate. On the northern side is the YSP Centre, Underground, Bothy & Garden Galleries and on the southern side you'll find Longside Gallery, a space shared with the Arts Council Collection.
