Not Vital is an explorer, an artist, a maker, designer, and dreamer.



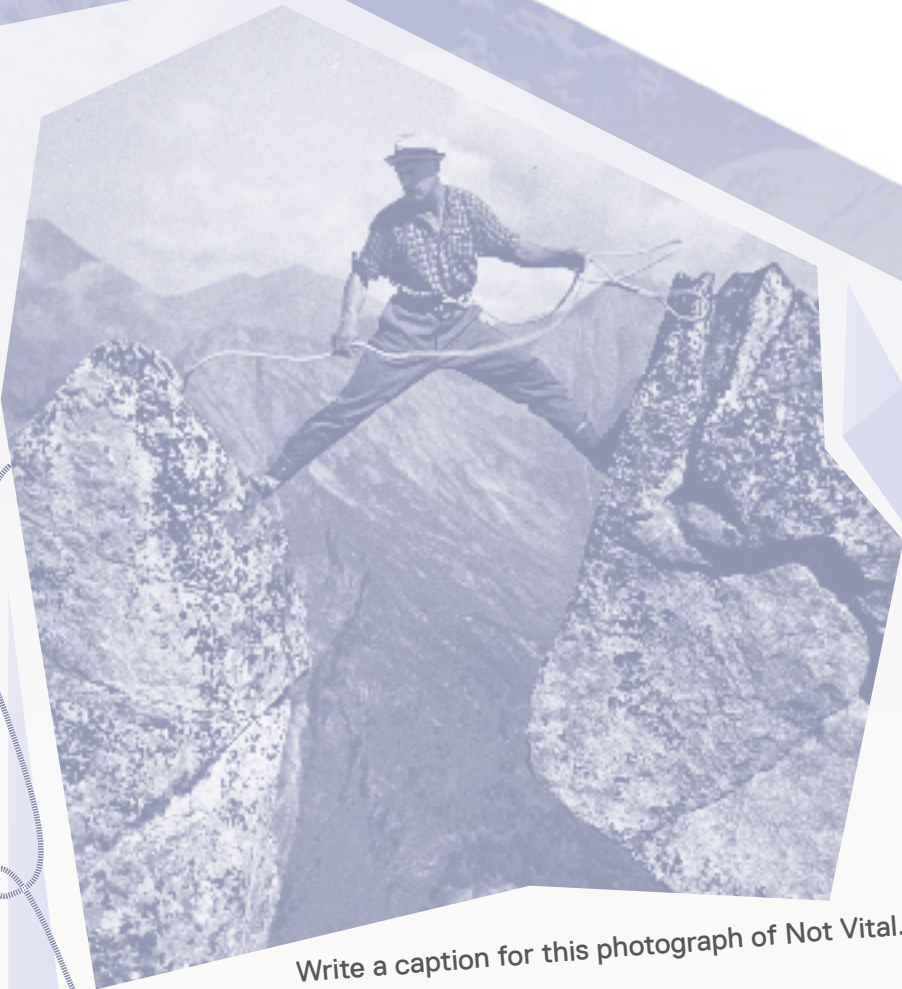
Not Vital has built towers to watch sunsets and gaze at the moon from.

Why has he done this?



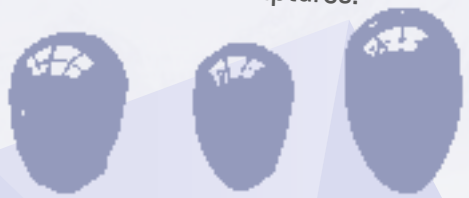
Not Vital suggests his paintings are like X-rays allowing you to see what's inside.
